

Eaton Percussion Ensemble - Important Information for; Packing, Moving, Unpacking, and Setting Up Percussion Instruments

- 1. Above all, be careful not to hurt yourself.
 - a. Use legs for lifting, not your back.
 - b. Don't pinch your hands/fingers with folding legs of mallet insts. and cym. stands.
 - c. Be careful not to smash hands when taking heavy objects through doorways. Go slowly!
 - d. When unloading heavy objects from a dolly, make sure they are balanced so that the remaining objects don't fall onto you or somebody else. Use of dollies will be explained.
- 2. When unloading the trucks, take all cases to the designated areas (according to your diagrams). This will make setting up the instruments **much** easier!
- 3. Use common sense to avoid damaging instruments and cases.
 - a. Don't slide them across the ground.
 - b. Don't set heavy items on top of smaller, lighter items.
 - c. Don't force something to fit into a box or case. Try a different position or the correct case!
 - d. Keep mallet inst. bags and cases clean by not stepping on or in them.
 - e. Attach and tighten all necessary braces before setting a mallet inst. upright. Use 2 people.
 - f. Be very careful not to drop or scratch mallet inst. bars and resonators. Use 2 people.
 - g. <u>Lift</u> timpani over door jams and bumps. Push pedal completely forward before moving. If a wheel falls off, get help putting it back on before setting down the drum.
 - h. Make sure case straps are buckled properly before moving a packed case.
 - i. Before setting small perc. insts. on trap tables or carpeted music stands, make sure the table or stand is secure/tight.
 - j. Don't drop or step on patch cords and power cords (to avoid breaking solder connections).
 - k. When setting up, open legs of cymbal stands, drum stands, etc. wide enough to prevent them from being knocked over easily. When packing, make stands no smaller than necessary to fit into upright stand cases. Put stands into the correct color-coded cases. Inside the cases, all stands face the same direction, with the legs (heaviest part of the stand) at the bottom.
 - 1. Be careful not to bang music stands or other objects into the edges of suspended cymbals.
 - m. Take clips off of triangles before packing them.
 - n. Check mixer and bass amp knobs to see that they didn't get moved/turned while packing.
 - o. Be sure black keyboard stand is tightly assembled before putting on keyboard and mixer.
 - p. Be careful not to misplace wing nuts, screws, etc. Replace them immediately after removing.
 - q. When positioning music stands, be careful not to let them scrape across mallet instrument bars
 - r. Put chime & vibe pedals up before moving them.
 - s. Neatly separate power, ext., & patch cords with a "twisty." Don't make loops too small (about 1 foot in diameter is good). Try to loop cords in their circular "trained" direction.
- 4. Before unpacking something from a case/box, take a few moments to see how it was packed. Take note of position in case and use of any special packing material.
- 5. Immediately after removing an inst. from a case, move the case (with any special packing material put back into the case) to the case storage area. Stack cases neatly to conserve space. Use your set-up chart to position insts. after assembling them.
- 6. If you finish your assigned set-up duties while other students are still working, you should assist them with their duties (only after you are <u>completely</u> finished with <u>your</u> assignments). You should never be goofing off while somebody else is actively working! This applies to packing, setting up, moving, and loading.
- 7. If an accident occurs or something breaks, report it to me immediately. I'll do my best to help correct the situation.
